## **Covid Test Results over the Easter Holidays**

If you or a member of your household develops Covid symptoms in the first week of the Easter holidays (up to Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April), you must take a Covid test and inform the school about a positive Covid test result. Don't forget that parents of children in school can request Lateral Flow Tests so that you can continue to check for asymptomatic Covid (ie when you are not displaying the known symptoms of a regular cough, raised temperature and loss of taste or smell).
