If your child will be celebrating Eid with your family, please remember to request a day's leave in advance. A request for leave form is available from the school office.

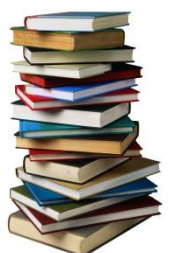
Free Energy Vouchers
