Face Masks

Due to the rising number of cases of COVID – 19 in Milton Keynes, it is important to wear face masks when dropping and picking up your child. Please maintain social distancing and use the Lateral Flow Tests twice weekly. These tests are available free of charge from chemists and allow you to check for Covid when you do not have symptoms.

If you or your children develop Covid symptoms – a regular cough or a raised temperature, you must book for a PCR test by going on line https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or phoning the NHS number 119.

We hope you all had a lovely half term and we are finally having some nice sunny weather. With that in mind, please remember to send your child to school with a clearly named sunhat and apply sun cream before they come into School so that they can enjoy playing outside safely.

This year has been a difficult one and the reading skills and confidence of many young readers has been affected. To boost reading over the summer holidays, we would like all our families to sign up to the MK

Reading Adventure. This is a wonderful opportunity to encourage reading just for the fun of it!

Children and young people are invited to sign up and take part between 1st July and 24th September. You can do this in any MK Library or online https://www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/libraries/children-and-teens/mkra. You will need to read 6 books to complete the challenge but can choose to read more.

On signing up children are given (or can print at home) a bookmark that they can use to track and rate the books they read/listen to and when they finish the challenge they can either show their bookmark to staff at one of the libraries or email a picture of it to: childrens.library@milton-keynes.gov.uk They will then be given (or emailed) a certificate, if they wish they can do the challenge more than once. Children can choose any books from a physical library or eBooks/eAudio via Libby https://www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/libraries/digital-books.

Please note that there are no stickers and medals this year because this is not being run as part of the Reading Agency's Summer Reading Challenge. But we hope that all families will join in.
