Plans for children Starting School in September are moving forward. Registration packs have been sent out to Nursery children who are starting in Reception class – please return these to the School office as soon as possible.

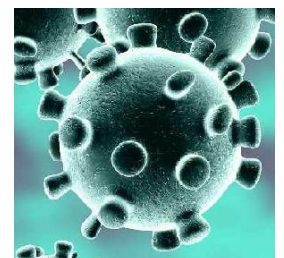


## **Class Allocation letters in September**
