Water Bottles

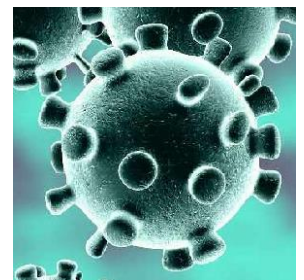
Please can we remind all parents/carers to fill their child's named bottle with water only, no juices or fizzy drinks. Water makes up more than half of a child's body. It is vital children drink enough fluid to maintain a healthy lifestyle.



COVID-19

Please remember if your child or anyone in your household has symptoms of COVID-19 you will need to book a PCR test as soon as symptoms appear.

The typical symptoms of COVID-19 are cough, fever or loss/change in smell/taste. However not everyone has these symptoms. Other symptoms can also include headache, fatigue and symptoms of the common cold. Around 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 do not have any symptoms but can still transmit the virus. Young children often have mild or no symptoms.



If someone in your household develops Covid-19 symptoms, however mild, please do not send children to school or nursery. Family members have to stay at home until the person with symptoms has a confirmed negative Covid PCR test.

You can book a FREE PCR test by calling 119 or visiting <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>.

A lateral Flow test (LFD) should only be used if you are showing NO symptoms but will tell you if you are infectious. Adults and children in secondary school should be doing a Lateral Flow test twice a week to monitor the spread of Covid-19. You can pick up Lateral Flow tests from any chemist. If a Lateral flow test shows a positive result, you will need to book a Covid PCR test to confirm the result.

If you have not booked a Covid-19 vaccination yet, anyone in the UK over the age of 18 can book theirs. You can do this online at: www.nhs.uk/book-a-coronavirus-vaccination. The vaccination centre at Saxon Court in Central Milton Keynes sometimes runs walk-in vaccination appointments, so please keep an eye on their website or social media.
