Nursery eligibility codes – 30 Hours

To keep your funded 30 hours nursery place, you must sign in every 3 months and confirm your details are up to date. This only takes a minute and you will need to do it even if your circumstances haven't changed. A reminder will usually be sent to you by HMRC by text and/or email and you will need to Login to your childcare account (Gov.uk) to reconfirm your eligibility. If you do not reconfirm in time you will then need to pay for your child's sessions.
