## **Nursery eligibility codes – 30 Hours**

To keep your funded 30 hours nursery place, you must sign in every 3 months and confirm your details are up to date. This only takes a minute and you will need to do it even if your circumstances haven't changed. A reminder will usually be sent to you by HMRC by text and/or email and you will need to [Login to your childcare account \(Gov.uk\)](#) to reconfirm your eligibility. If you do not reconfirm in time you will then need to pay for your child's sessions.
