### Flu Immunisations – Reception and KS1 children

Don't forget that Reception and KS1 children can get a flu vaccination in school, but you need to have completed an on-line consent form. The information about this was sent to parents by email a couple of weeks ago, but we will re-send it today because **the deadline is**Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November. There is now an option for children who cannot have the nasal spray because it contains porcine gelatine to opt for an injectable vaccine. Nursery children can be given a flu vaccination through their GP or Health visitor.
