Please remember when travelling to School via car that all children are required to use a child car seat which is correctly fitted based on your child's height or weight and be strapped in appropriately at all times.

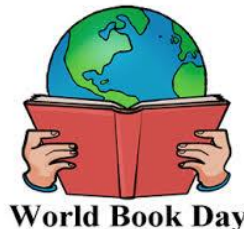
