## Willows World Book Day

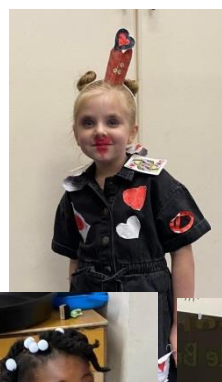
We loved seeing the children come into school on Wednesday in their world book day costumes. They had great fun talking about their different costumes and the stories behind them.
