## **Bag 2 School collection day – Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October**



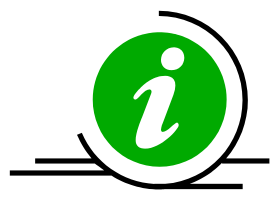
