## Medicine



The only medicines we give to children on a parent's behalf are those prescribed by a Doctor and issued by a pharmacist.

Generally we do not give ibuprofen or paracetamol on behalf of parents. However in exceptional circumstances such as when a parent has a work commitment we can administer these for you.

You will still need to fill in a medicine consent form.

You must **not** send your child into school with any medicine in their school bag or expect your child to take the medicine themselves. If another child found the medicine and took it by mistake, this could cause another child to become ill.
