Child Car Seat Safety Checks



On Thursday 12 March, Road Safety officers from Thames Valley Police will be at Tesco Extra in Kingston conducting child seat safety checks.

Please come along between 10am and 2pm if you need any help or have any questions about child seats.

Members of the In-Car Safety Centre, MK Council and Bucks Fire and Rescue will also be there with advice and information.

It is important that you have the correct type of seat for your child to ensure they are safe whilst travelling in a car. Children must use a child seat until they are 12 years old or at least 135cm tall – whichever comes first.

There are height-based seats and weight-based seats available so it is important to always check what type of seat you have and whether it is appropriate depending on your child's height or weight.
