SUMMER READING CHALLENGE

Milton Keynes Libraries are excited to announce that they will be participating fully in the Reading Agency's annual Summer Reading Challenge for the first time since 2019.

Children can sign up from **Friday 22nd July 2022** and should complete the challenge by **Saturday 10th September 2022**. They can take part at any Milton Keynes Library (including the new Woughton Library) during staffed hours.

Who is it for?

- The challenge is for children of all ages and it is free to join. The aim of the challenge is to encourage children to borrow books from the library, enjoy reading, to maintain their reading skill and confidence to avoid the summer reading dip.

What do they do?

- They need to read six library books during the school holidays; these can be whatever interests them: stories, information books or comic books. They can also download eBooks and eAudio Books from the Libby and BorrowBox apps with their library membership.

What do they get?

- Each time they finish a book they collect a sticker.
- Halfway through they will receive a bookmark
- Once they read six books they will receive a certificate and a medal (while stocks last!).

Does it cost anything to join the library?

- It's free to join the library and borrow books but a child's parent/carer needs to fill out a form on the child's behalf.
