Pancake Tuesday

The children have been making and eating pancakes this week. You might want to try and make some over half term.

Ingredients. 100g plain flour. 2 large eggs. 300ml milk. 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil, plus a little extra for frying.

Put all the ingredients in a large bowl and whisk until you have a smooth batter.



Heat a little oil in a frying pan and when it is hot, pour a layer of pancake mixture into and frying pan and cook your pancakes for 1 minute on each side and serve with your favourite topping – perhaps a little lemon juice and caster sugar.
